The Aircraft Owners & Pilots Association (AOPA) is seeking your assistance in support of legislation that will help your businesses be more competitive. Maryland <u>House Bill 318</u> / <u>Senate Bill 212</u> aims to exempt sales of aircraft parts and materials from state sales taxes. The House Ways & Means Committee has tasked the bill's sponsors with quantifying the bill's actual 'fiscal impact'. The below information will be collected for use in providing statistically valid data to be used in furtherance of legislative initiatives with State Legislators. **The survey responses will not be made public**.
