## Each application set must include:

- A completed International Cessna 190/195 Foundation Scholarship Application Form
  - This form may be downloaded at www.cessna195.org/foundation
- Printed transcripts from all high schools, colleges, flight or trade schools verifying GPAs.
- A 500 word, typed descriptive essay that details:
  - The training for which you need assistance
  - Your aviation history and goals
  - o How the scholarship will help you achieve your goals
  - o What you have done for yourself to achieve your goals
  - Where you see yourself in five and ten years
  - Where and when you will obtain and complete your training
  - o Any previous educational scholarships, awards, and honors.
  - o Your present financial need
- Your professional resume
  - o Include three (3) references (at least one (1) from an aviation or aeronautical professional).

## In addition, IF APPLICABLE, copies of:

- All aviation licenses
- Medical certificate
- The last three (3) pages of your pilot logbook

## The selection criteria will include:

- Attitude towards self and others
- Commitment to success
- Dedication to career
- Financial need
- Previous achievements

Applications must be postmarked by May 1 of each year to be eligible for award for the fall semester. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
