OPERATIONS AUTHORIZED

Waiver to 14 CFR Part 91.126(d) for pilot communication requirements prior to operating within 4 nautical miles of the Air Traffic Control Tower (ATCT) at Houston Executive Airport (TME). TME will have an operational ATCT commencing October 1, 2014. Aircraft operating at the following altitudes and/or locations are not required to contact TME ATCT in accordance with the requirement in 14 CFR 91.126(d) to establish two-way communication:

- 1. Aircraft departing, arriving, or operating in the pattern at Sport Flyers Airport (27XS) within 4 nautical miles from TME bound by the coordinates N29/51/37 W95/56/27, N29/51/00 W95/55/41, N29/49/40 W95/55/41, N29/48/56 W95/56/24, N29/48/29 W95/57/05, N29/48/29 W95/58/05, N29/48/29 W95/58/28, and/or
- 2. Aircraft transiting through the area within 4 nautical miles of TME airport at or above 2000 feet mean sea level (MSL).


