The Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association (AOPA), representing over 410,000 general aviation pilots and members nationwide, requests that the Otis Air National Guard Base (Otis ANG) extend the public comment period for the Environmental Assessment (EA) on the proposed reorganization and expansion of the Condor MOAs, located near Sugarloaf Mountain, ME.

AOPA and the local pilot community were not notified of the availability of the EA and the subsequent comment period. In fact, a local member learned of the action in a recent newspaper article and brought the issue to our attention. To allow AOPA and the local airspace users adequate time to analyze and provide comments to the EA, AOPA is requesting the comment period deadline be extended by 30 days.
