Truth Or Consequences, NM

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 332933N/1062457W or the TCS VOR 73.9 degree radial at 45.4NM.
- B. Dates and times:

31 MAY	0200 – 1200Z
01 – 03 JUN	0200 – 0700Z
04 – 07 JUN	0200 – 1200Z
08 JUN	0701 – 1200Z
10 JUN	0701 – 1200Z
11 – 13 JUN	0200 – 1200Z
15 – 17 JUN	0200 – 0700Z
18 – 21 JUN	0200 – 1200Z
22 – 23 JUN	0701 – 1200Z
24 JUN	0200 – 0700Z
25 – 28 JUN	0200 – 1200Z
29 – 30 JUN	0200 – 0700Z

- C. Duration: Testing will be continuous during requested times.
- D. During testing, the GPS signal may be unreliable or unavailable within a 460NMR centered at 332933N/1062457W or the TCS VOR 73.9 degree radial at 45.4 NM at FL400 and above, decreasing in area with decrease in altitude to 445NMR at FL250, 335NMR at 10,000 FT MSL, 335NMR at 4,000 FT AGL and 265NMR at 50 FT AGL.
- E. Pilots are strongly encouraged to report anomalies during testing to the appropriate ARTCC to assist in the determination of the extent of GPS degradation during tests.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
