



# NOTICE TO ALL CONCERNED

**SUBJECT: CASE NO. 11-AAL-11NR**

**PROPOSED DECOMMISSIONING**

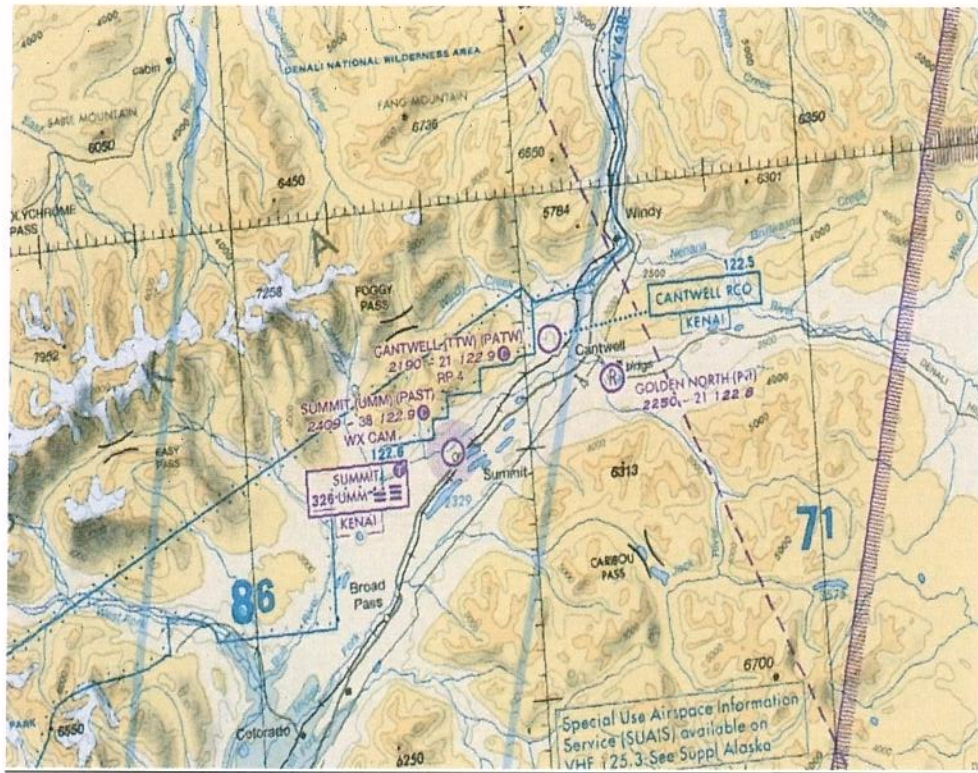
**Summit Non-Directional Beacon**

**Cantwell, Alaska**

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is conducting an aeronautical study of a proposal to decommission the Summit Non-Directional Beacon (UMM NDB) which is located near Cantwell, AK. The proposal is to decommission the NDB and remove the associated hardware infrastructure without replacement. There are no instrument approach procedures associated with the UMM NDB. There will also be no reclassification of existing airspace and the current Federal Airways will not be affected. However, the UMM NDB does provide a Transcribed Weather Broadcast (TWEB) from the Kenai Automated Flight Service Station and this TWEB service will be discontinued if the NDB is decommissioned. The intent of this notice is to inform the flying public of the proposal to decommission and remove the Summit NDB (UMM) and TWEB and provide an opportunity to comment.

DATES: Comments must be received on or before June 25, 2011.

OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT: Interested parties are invited to participate in this proposal by submitting such written data, views, or arguments as they may desire. Comments that provide the factual basis supporting the views and suggestions presented are particularly helpful in developing reasoned decisions on the proposal. Comments are specifically invited on the overall aeronautical, economic, environmental, and energy-related aspects of the proposal. Communications should identify the airspace docket and be submitted to the address listed below. Responders wishing the FAA to acknowledge receipt of their comments on this notice must submit with the comments a self-addressed, stamped postcard on which the following statement is made: "Comments to Airspace Docket No. 11-AAL-09NR." All communications received on or before the specified closing date for comments will be considered before taking action on the proposal. The proposal contained in this notice may be changed in light of comments received.
