GPS Testing
ACC GPS 11-09
July 12, 2011 – July 22, 2011
Las Vegas, NV

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 374922N/1154507W or the TPH VOR 102.1 degree radial at 62.1NM.
- B. Dates and times: GPS testing is scheduled on July 12th through July 22nd, 2011 from 0700-1300 UTC daily.
- C. Duration: Each event may last up to 2 hours and may start at any time during the requested periods.
- D. During testing, the GPS signal may be unreliable or unavailable within a 510NMR centered at 374922N/1154507W or the TPH VOR 102.1 degree radial at 62.1 NM at FL400 and above, decreasing in area with decrease in altitude to 460NMR at FL250, 405NMR at 10,000 FT MSL, 340NMR at 4,000 FT AGL and 275NMR at 50 FT AGL.
- E. Pilots are strongly encouraged to report anomalies during testing to the appropriate ARTCC to assist in the determination of the extent of GPS degradation during tests.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
