Conditions of Appointment of Volunteer

- 1. By appointing Volunteer as a participant in the AOPA Airport Support Network program, AOPA has placed Volunteer in a position of trust and confidence within the AOPA family, and prominence in the aviation community. Volunteer is expected to conduct himself or herself within the scope of the appointment as defined by AOPA, in a professional manner that will reflect credit upon Volunteer and AOPA. A Volunteer will avoid any activity that conflicts with AOPA or any of its affiliated organizations or persons, or creates the appearance of such a conflict of interest. A volunteer will not use his or her status with AOPA in connection with any commercial activity.
- 2. A Volunteer is expected to maintain a listening watch for matters affecting the airport for which the appointment is made, and to report to AOPA within the reasonable discretion of the Volunteer. To that end, a Volunteer is expected to maintain a liaison with airport authorities and with others the Volunteer determines have a credible and substantial interest in the airport. A Volunteer is generally not a spokesperson for AOPA. A Volunteer has no authority to take a policy position on behalf of AOPA unless that position has first been approved by AOPA staff. This includes signing letters as the ASN Volunteer.
- 3. The appointment as a Volunteer in the AOPA Airport Support Network is terminable at any time upon written notice by either the Volunteer or AOPA. Upon termination, AOPA will cease, as soon as practicable, representing Volunteer as a participant in the Network; and Volunteer will cease, as soon as practicable, all Network activities and will cease representing himself or herself as a participant in the Network or as a representative of AOPA.
- 4. A Volunteer is not an employee of AOPA, and no compensation will be paid for services rendered by Volunteer to AOPA or to the aviation community.
- 5. A Volunteer has no authority to bind AOPA contractually. A volunteer, acting within the scope of his or her appointment, will not be engaging in any activity which could subject AOPA to any liability for death, personal injury or property damage. A volunteer has no authority to utilize an aircraft or operate a vehicle in connection with the performance of volunteer services under his or her appointment.
- 6. Appointed Volunteers consent to receiving ASN related communications from AOPA, including via email.
- 7. These Conditions of Appointment may be revised by AOPA from time to time.
