RE: REIMBURSEMENTS TO PILOTS

ON OCTOBER 28, 2010, THE FAA ISSUED EXEMPTION LETTERS TO WINGS OF MERCY, INC. AND ANGEL FLIGHT MID-ATLANTIC (INCLUDING AFFILIATES, AIRLIFT HOPE OF AMERICA AND MERCY MEDICAL AIRLIFT).

THE EXEMPTIONS ALLOW PILOTS TO RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT FOR FUEL **FROM THESE ORGANIZATIONS, AND THESE ORGANIZATIONS ONLY**, PROVIDED THAT BOTH THE ORGANIZATIONS AND PILOTS CONFORM TO EXTENSIVE CONDITIONS SET FORTH IN THE EXEMPTION LETTERS.

ANY OTHER ORGANIZATION SEEKING TO REIMBURSE PILOTS MUST OBTAIN ITS OWN EXEMPTION LETTER FROM THE FAA BEFORE DOING SO.
