The training is indeed accelerated, but it never feels rushed. The structure is clear, the expectations are high, and the support is always there. The instructors pay attention to the smallest details, they notice your weaknesses early, help you work through them, and make sure you improve flight after flight. Other than that, they have a whatsapp group for alumni so I feel connected even after graduating.</p>

83.00	<p>Below is my Google maps review I left shortly after completing the course - I stand by what I said then: I did the 14 day PPL program. The name is not an exaggeration, but it is not "bootcamp" or full of shortcuts either; the course is literally an entire PPL worth of training, but with a dedicated instructor and aircraft reserved so you can fly/train everyday and take your checkride all within a small time window. Ultimately you need to be able to develop the skill within that time frame and put the effort in to make that happen. I'd highly recommend taking their "POES" ground school via the webinars before starting, as just doing something like Sporty's ground school course alone and getting a high score in the written will not be enough; if I could go back and choose to take this before flying out to LA I'd have definitely done it before. My instructor Eric was super flexible and we were able to make the program fit around my work schedule, as I was still working remotely during the course. Johan and the local team were very persistent in ensuring my check ride would go ahead, and making alternative arrangements in case the DPE had to move the time slot or cancel. Ultimately the PPL is a license to learn, and the 14DP staff teach with that philosophy in mind. I now have my FAA PPL which I can convert to a local license in the country I live in, and continue getting experience/building PIC time here. I'm sure I'll be back in KVNY for the 10 day instrument rating before I know it ☺ Thank you 14daypilot!</p>

87.00	<p>Dr Gema and his team of dedicated instructors, particularly Hawra, was instrumental in ensuring that my CAAS restricted PPL was 'unlocked' through undergoing rigorous cross country navigation flight module in January 2024 at Van Nuys. By way of background, Singapore, where I am from, is a city state with an area of 700 sq km. Hence, general aviation students would only get restricted PPL (meaning only able to fly within Singapore) since Singapore is too small for the conduct of cross country navigation flights. To 'unlock' the PPL, CAAS requires general aviation students to undergo an approved cross country navigation flight with training providers. At the time when I underwent the course, 14DayFlightSchool is the only entity recognised by CAAS to conduct the course. From day 1, it quickly struck me that Dr Gema did not run his school on strictly commercial terms. He was truly interested in doing his best to ensure his students get the best opportunities to achieve their respective aviation objectives. At his own cost, he frequently held meal sessions to promote camaraderie, a strict culture of safety compliance and a nurturing spirit for all his students, me included. Within a matter of 1 week, I completed my module and was able to apply to CAAS to unlock my restricted PPL. Since then, I have undertaken many cross country navigation flights as PIC.</p>

I left with restored confidence in my flying. Not only do I feel safer and more comfortable as a pilot, but I have also gained access to an active community of pilots. This is one of the hidden benefits of 14DP that I did not expect.
83.00	14DP is committed to ensuring a high quality of flight training to its students. For context I am based in Singapore and had flown in to the US to train for the Private Pilot Licence. A few exceptional aspects of the school that set it apart: - This was the only school that committed to getting me ready for the check ride in a 6 week period. Most schools summarily dismissed my request and said it was not possible if I couldn't spent 6 months in the US - They set up the check ride date with the DPE upfront and that gave me a definite goal to work towards. As a result, it was extremely intense and I needed to work extra hard preparing to be ready prior to the check ride date, and the instructors put in the work preparing you. Unlike many other students from other schools who finish the training and then wait for weeks/months to line up a check ride - They front loaded the theory, oral prep, simulator including live ATC through Pilot edge, in their Asia office. By the time I arrived in the US my theory was top notch (I received 97% on my written test which I took the day after I landed in the US. My DPE also commended me on the depth of knowledge on the oral part of the check ride) - Strong set of Instructors with very different personalities and way of teaching. I was able to learn different nuances based on the extensive flying experience of the instructors. Naturally the tensions are high during the training and sometimes students dont gel with a certain instructor. They are able to have instructors step in who are more aligned to your learning needs/temperament as needed - The founder Captain Dr. Gema Goeyardi is passionate about teaching. He spent hours training me personally in Indonesia (simulator, theory, pilot edge etc.) and during flying in the US prepping me before the check ride. He allows student to take as much time as they need to practice their theory and skills on the simulator, before heading to the US. By the time I came to US I had already flown the routes that I would fly in the US and was somewhat familiar with them. - The strong student community that helps each others. Before joining I was able to speak to past students and learn about the experience and the logistics for the stay in the US. Throughout my time in the US I was getting tips on flying and exam prep from students who were ahead of me. There is a strong culture of paying it forward with supporting newer pilots There is one aspect that I struggled with a bit. The scheduling of flying hours is handled by someone in Jakarta, and not on the ground. Miscommunications on learning priorities can happen from time to time. Where it ended up being an issue for me was when I had hit a snag on a particular skill on landing. My lead instructor was away and the team in Jakarta paired me with an instructor who put me under a lot of pressure. The school kept scheduling hours of flying when what I needed was a break and a different instructor. I ended up flying for extra hours and felt I got worse/lost confidence. Eventually I escalated the matter and a senior instructor stepped in and helped me regain confidence and taught me simple tricks to get over the issue I was facing. But all in all, this was an experience of a lifetime and I thank 14 Day Pilot for their dedication.
