First, all aircraft are consistently maintained at the highest standards by the affiliated partnership with Airspeed and Attitude avionics and maintenance shop that is consider the premier go-to place for legacy aircraft across North Texas. This gives me great confidence in addition to the similarly high standards set for instruction and all CFI's by and with the school's leadership leading by example in their individual instruction, and with the SOPs expected of each CFI. Also, I think their decision to pay fair wages on a W-2 (vs 1099) basis has a lot to do with attracting a high quality corps of CFIs that allows booking with any of them and expecting a similar high-quality experience. I've flown with multiple CFIs, though one primarily, and can attest to this from my own experience. Beyond those two critical pieces, they have a more than adequate inventory of aircraft that allows for plenty of access to flight training to be scheduled regularly so I can stay on the pace I have set for myself and coordinate with my CFI. They have also consistently offered quality ground session both for individual and small group settings. Plenty of support is available through multiple means made available through their high-touch approach along with tools like Flight Circle and social media to connect with the dozens and dozens of students who are students of A+A. The responsiveness, care and concern demonstrated by all staff adds to my gratitude for finding what I've come to see is a seemingly rare opportunity to have all these positive aspects happening at a single Part 61 school.
