Safety is emphasized through all of the required pre-flight activities such as weight and balance calculations, performance calculations, FRAT submissions, and pre-flight inspection of the aircraft. We are made aware of the cost of each individual item (plane, instructor, fuel, groundschool) so there are no surprises there and they even offer discounts in certain situations. Overall, I have had a really positive experience at Avier. Their main focus isn't just teaching us how to fly, but to really give us everything we need to become safe and successful professional pilots.

10.1 Questionnaire Responses

The Net Promoter Score is generated by asking customers how likely they would be to recommend a given product or service - in this case, your services as a flight instructor to another potential customer, on an 11 point scale.

10.2 NPS Grouping

Responses to this question are then used to sort customers into one of three groups:

Detractor: Less likely to use your services again and may not speak highly of your services to others.

Passive: Generally somewhat satisfied, passive respondents likely won't help or hurt your business in talking to other people.

Promoters: Ideally, all of your customers would be promoters. Promoters would fly with you again in the future and would tell others how great they think you are.

10.3 Standardized Score Calculation

The overall Net Promoter Score is calculated by subtracting the percentage of your customers who are 'detractors' from the percentage of your customers who are 'promoters.' Thus, the overall Net Promoter Score can range from -100 to 100.
