



Report for Neu Aviation at KDTN (Shreveport Downtown Airport)

Region: Awards Consideration (includes report card)

Below is a summary of scores and feedback from all the usable evaluations which were submitted for you during the 2026 Flight Training Experience Award application period. Many flight training providers receive exceptionally high scores so we also share with you the distribution of the overall aggregate scores for comparison.

1. Eligibility

To be eligible for an award, you needed to receive at least 10 unique evaluations, each at least 80% complete.

A survey response was considered 'usable' if the respondent answered at least 80% of the questions required for scoring.

A Flight School was considered 'eligible' for an award if they received at least 10 unique, usable responses.

Average scores were based on all usable responses received and have been rounded where necessary

Percentile ranks were calculated at both national and regional levels and may have been rounded.

They treat each instructor and each student with compassion and caring, and it makes the life of an instructor much easier. I have been able to rely on both Molly and Collin for support and mentorship throughout this time, and they have proven to be very helpful. And students are not just a number here, but they are individuals with their own stories, strengths, and weaknesses. Collin and Molly take steps to ensure that each student receives the instruction and the support they need to succeed-- and they know that it is different for every student. Collin and Molly have a clear vision and desire for growth here in the Northwest Region of Louisiana. In a matter of 3 years, Neu Aviation became the largest flight school in this region-- with about 70 active students, 9 instructors, and 7 aircraft. This filled a great need for advanced training that many other aviators were unable to achieve locally until now. In January, they created the program, and so far, we have completed training for 20 students with a 100% checkride pass rate. For the aviators in Shreveport and beyond, Neu Aviation is building an incredible flight training resource that is quickly growing and maintaining excellence. I am very proud to be an instructor for this flight school, and I believe they deserve the award for the best flight school in the country.
