Many flight training providers receive exceptionally high scores so we also share with you the distribution of the overall aggregate scores for comparison.

1. Eligibility

To be eligible for an award, you needed to receive at least 10 unique evaluations, each at least 80% complete.

A survey response was considered 'usable' if the respondent answered at least 80% of the questions required for scoring.

A Flight School was considered 'eligible' for an award if they received at least 10 unique, usable responses.

Average scores were based on all usable responses received and have been rounded where necessary

Your percentile rank was calculated by comparing your score to scores of all other(nominated/eligible) Flight Schools

Percentile ranks were calculated at both national and regional levels and may have been rounded.

As a frequent renter and soon-to-be aircraft owner who trains and flies regularly out of Northwest Flight Service, I have seen firsthand how seriously this school treats safety — not just in words, but in systems, culture, and people. One of the greatest strengths of Northwest Flight Service is its full-service in-house maintenance team. Having A&P/IA mechanics on staff — people who know the fleet individually and maintain it proactively — is an enormous safety advantage compared to the “fix it when it breaks somewhere else on the field” model that many other schools rely on. Recently, when an aircraft in the Cirrus fleet needed attention, Matt Hamm and the maintenance team mobilized immediately to get it safely returned to service. Watching how they diagnose, communicate, and verify the work gives pilots tremendous confidence. Their precision and pride in doing it right is obvious, and it directly protects students, renters, CFI's, and the community under the pattern. Flight instruction is only as safe as the machines we train in. 10.1 Questionnaire Responses

10.2 NPS Grouping

Responses to this question are then used to sort customers into one of three groups:

Detractor: Less likely to use your services again and may not speak highly of your services to others.

Passive: Generally somewhat satisfied, passive respondents likely won't help or hurt your business in talking to other people.

Promoters: Ideally, all of your customers would be promoters. Promoters would fly with you again in the future and would tell others how great they think you are.

10.3 Standardized Score Calculation
