

**AOPA's 2016 HIGH SCHOOL AVIATION STEM SYMPOSIUM SWEEPSTAKES  
OFFICIAL RULES**

1. **NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. MAKING A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.**
2. Open to all individual attendees sixteen (16) years of age or older as of the date of entry who attend the final session of AOPA's 2016 High School Aviation STEM Symposium at the Museum of Flight, 9404 E. Marginal Way South, Seattle Washington from 1:00pm to 4:00pm on November 7, 2016. If any winner is 16 years of age or older, but less than 18 years of age, the winners' parent or legal guardian may be required to consent to the award of the prize and sign any required consent/affidavit. The sweepstakes is not open to employees of AOPA its subsidiaries and affiliated companies, or their advertising and promotion agencies. Any person in the immediate family of an employee (including the spouse, children, parents, brothers and sisters of any employee) living in the same household of any such employee is also not eligible to win.
3. The **grand prize** is two (2) Alaska Airline coach, round-trip tickets. Tickets are valid for travel to destination served by Alaska Airlines and/or Horizon Air with the exception of Cuba. Not valid for flights operated by Alaska Airline codeshare partners. Tickets expire one year after the date of issuance. Approximate retail value ("ARV") of each ticket is \$1,250.00.
4. All prizes will be awarded. The total approximate retail value ("ARV") of all prizes is \$2,500.00.
5. Enter by completing an official entry form available at the registration table at the Museum of Flight in Seattle, Washington from 1:00pm-4:00pm November 7, 2016 ("Entry Period").
6. Winner will be determined by random drawing. At approximately 4:10 pm on November 7, 2016 an employee of AOPA will select, or cause to be selected, by random drawing one (1) grand prize winner from all valid entries during the Entry Period. Winner must be present to win. In the event winner first drawn is not present or does not claim the prize he or she will be disqualified and another winner will be selected. and will be notified by mail. AOPA will award the prize to the winner upon verification of eligibility.
7. Limit one (1) entry per person. Incomplete, unofficial or illegible forms -- where the information may not be reasonably determined -- are void and will be discarded.
8. Winner agrees to be photographed by and have his/her name and likeness used by AOPA and prize providers for the purposes of promoting the sweepstakes, AOPA and prize providers. Winner is solely responsible for any taxes that may be payable as a result of their winning and must provide an IRS Form W9 to AOPA.
9. **Void where prohibited. Subject to all federal, state & local laws.** Odds of winning determined by number of entries.
10. **Limited liability.** By participating in the sweepstakes, all participants agree to be bound by these official rules and the decisions of AOPA and its employees, whose decisions regarding the sweepstakes shall be final. By accepting any prize, winner agrees that the prizes are awarded without any warranties, expressed or implied, and AOPA disclaims all such warranties, and further agree to hold harmless the officers, directors and employees of AOPA, their families, heirs and assigns (collectively, "AOPA") from any and all injuries or damages arising out of the use of the prizes. Any warranty regarding any of the prizes is strictly limited to the warranty and guarantee that may be assigned by the manufacturers.
11. **Dispute resolution.** Participants agree that: (a) any disputes arising out of or in connection with this Sweepstakes, or any prizes awarded, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action; (b) any judicial proceeding shall take place in a federal or state court within the State of Maryland; (c) damages shall be limited to direct, out-of-pocket damages and shall not include attorneys' fees; and (d) all issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the state of Maryland without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules that would cause the application of the laws of any other jurisdiction..
